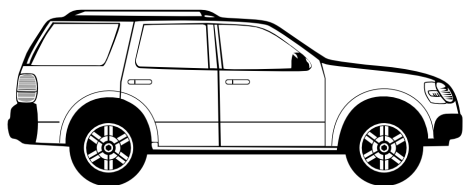
Tuesday, August 23
