# October 24: Spokane Falls Postal History









Larry Mann will do a presentation on the postal history of Spokane Falls from 1872-91. The city's post office was established on July 5, 1872, and early cancellations at first identified the city as "Spokan Falls," before switching to "Spokane Falls" in the mid 1880s. Washington became a state on November 11, 1889, and the name of the city was changed to "Spokane" on April 24, 1891.
