## Virtual SEAPEX Show <u>www.seapexshow.org/</u>



This year's SEAPEX will be a "virtual" stamp show, held on Friday through Sunday, **September 11-13**. It will include links to stamp dealers, online exhibits, and live meetings and presentations that you can attend.

The site (<u>www.seapexshow.org/</u>) is still under construction, but SEAPEX President Carol J. Edholm hopes to have it completed by **September 1**. The "door" to the show, as shown at left, has the following four links:

- Stamp Dealers: Click the link to view a list of participating dealers. Click a dealer name to view their website with a list of what they are selling. This is still under construction and won't be ready until September 11, the first day of the show.
- Exhibits: Click the link to view a list of online exhibits, and click a title to view an exhibit. Some of the exhibits can be viewed now, although the exhibits section is also still under construction. The deadline has already passed to submit multi-frame exhibits, but single frame exhibits (including "free style" exhibits with no exhibit rules, and club exhibits can be submitted until August 22. To submit an exhibit, scan the pages in .jpeg format at 300 to 600 DPI and email the pages in the order that they should be displayed to <u>SEAPEX.show@gmail.com</u>
- **Presentations** & **Meetings:** Click either link to view the presentations and meetings that can be attended as Zoom meetings. Each one will be at a scheduled time. You can register for presentations and meetings starting on September 1. When you do that you will receive an emailed Zoom link. Click the Zoom link to start the meeting.
