Enter as many lots as you desire. Starting price on each lot should be around \$3.00. Bidding increments are not applicable. Lots will be awarded to the highest bidder as of the end of the designated time. **The silent auction ends at 3:40 PM.** 

AUCTION II - REGULAR FLOOR BID AUCTION. Everyone is urged to enter at least three lots. Additional lots may be entered at the discretion of the auctioneer. Time constraints limit floor lots to not more than 150. Minimum opening bid is \$3.00 per lot or the seller's stated minimum selling price. Minimum price, if any, must be stated on the lot card. Bidding increments will be announced by the auctioneer.

#### **AUCTION RULES**

- Precautions will be taken to safeguard auction lots.
- Insurance is the responsibility of the seller.
