John Robison will speak about techniques he uses to lift stamps from paper without damaging them. His focus is on mint stamps, preserving as much of the original gum as possible when they are lightly stuck together or on a page.

Chuck was generous in giving stamps away (including to this editor when I started collecting French stamps a few years ago. Chuck and I were friends, and also attended the same church. We made occasional visits together to the stamp shop, followed by lunch, and sometimes went out to dinner together with our wives. I will miss those times together!)

Chuck was a retired dentist, a veteran, and he and his wife lived for many years in Northern California, before moving to Spokane. He and his wife, Vivian, often attended our club's Christmas dinner. We will miss him!
