Traveling the World of Philately & I Never Met a Stamp I Didn't Like

We are pleased to welcome a special guest who will give our September program. Alex Haimann is an experienced collector who has been involved in philately at both the national and international levels. Haimann worked as a collections specialist and web projects developer for the Smithsonian National Postal Museum from 2005-10, served the American Philatelic Society as chair of the Board of Vice Presidents from 2013-16, and served as the chair of the Campaign for Philately Committee from 2016-22. He also served on the World Stamp Show New York 2016 and Stockholmia 2019 committees.

Haimann exhibited his Anglo-Zulu War postal history collection ("Clash of Empires: The 1879 Anglo-Zulu War," www.clashofempires.org) at the Royal Philatelic Society in London in 2023. Videos of the exhibition have been viewed by more than a million



people on YouTube, and material from the exhibit appeared in an article in the *American Philatelist*.

Haimann is visiting Spokane this month, and will be speaking about his experiences "traveling the world of philately" and his claim that he "never met a stamp he didn't like." Since 2008, he has given dozens of talks across the US to both philatelic and non-philatelic audiences. Be sure to come hear this special program!
